2024-2025 Financial Policy

Please bring Enrollment Fee and Application Paperwork to the School Office. Families will be invoiced for Tuition based on payment plan chosen below. Payment can be made via credit card thru PayTrace or check. Marian Hope offers an online payment option through PayTrace. Look for "Make Payment" at the top of marianhopeacademy.org website and follow instructions. Within PayTrace, there is a box to enter special details about your transaction: Ex: paying Tuition/enrollment/curriculum fee for (student's name). You can make one payment or set up reoccurring payments. A convenience fee of \$1.00 is charged per transaction to your credit card. Checks are made out to MHA.

*Enrollment Fee: (Kindergarten-12th grade) Due at time of Enrollment and is Non-Refundable

\$200.00 per student (Families will pay the max of \$600.00)

*Academic Fees: (K -12) Academic Fees Are Non-Refundable – invoices are emailed for academic fees by July 1

(Academic resources, classroom supplies, technology)

Kindg-5th Grade: \$500.00 per student - due in full by July 1 6-12th Grade: \$600.00 per student - due in full by July 1

- *<u>Activity Fees:</u> Parents will be informed of any planned extra-curricular activities/field trips outside of the Academy. Any costs associated with these activities will be paid by the parent/students before the activity.
- *Specialized Learning Program Fees: Families of students who are educated in any of our Specialized Learning Classes will pay \$500.00 if their student is in 1-2 classes and \$1,000.00 for 3 or more classes. This yearly cost is in addition to the standard tuition shown below.
- * these fees are in addition to tuition

MHA is a full day school Monday-Friday

If your family chooses the one payment option, payment is due by August 1st. If your family selects the two payment option, installments are due no later than August 1st and February 1st. With the three payment option, installments are due no later than August 1st, November 1st & February 1st. *All bills must be paid in full by May 1st of the current school year*. As per MHA policy, a student cannot be enrolled in the following school year until the current year is paid in full. If a student withdraws during the school year, their account must be paid in full before the grade card/transcript is sent to the transferring school.

<u>Additional Contributions:</u> Any additional contributions are tax-deductible and greatly needed and appreciated. We will strive to keep our tuition as low as possible while ensuring we cover all costs & maintain our low teacher-student ratio.

Late Academic/Tuition Fees: If not paid on time, a \$45 late fee will be added each month until the account is current.

Past-due Accounts: Excessively late tuition may result in student dismissal.

<u>Scholarship Tuition Assistance</u>: Applications can be requested from Sue Stickney in the office. Please note that the Marian Hope scholarship account is limited. Qualifying families will be awarded scholarships when funds are available.

*Individual Para Costs: If it is determined your student needs one-on-one para support, admin staff will contact you. Parents are responsible for covering the full-time para's cost in addition to our standard fees. Para costs average between \$20.00-\$22.00/hour.
